**A RESOLUTION REGARDING GOVERNOR GIANFORTE'S FEBRUARY 2021
COVID-19 RESTRICTIONS**

WHEREAS, Montana Governor Greg Gianforte has declared a State of Emergency related to COVID-19, and

WHEREAS, the Fergus County Commissioners declared a State of Emergency related to COVID-19 on the 18th of March 2020, and

WHEREAS, as a result of those declarations, restrictions have been placed on schools, businesses, other entities, and individuals, and

WHEREAS, the Fergus County Commissioners have confidence that citizens will continue to take necessary precautions for their own personal safety due to concerns surrounding COVID-19 and to act reasonably to protect their health, and

WHEREAS, the Fergus County Commissioners also have confidence that schools, businesses and other entities have the knowledge and expertise to implement the Governor's directives to the best of their ability in these situations

WHEREAS, Fergus County recognizes and appreciates the efforts and support everyone has made in complying with the COVID-19 restrictions, and

WHEREAS, Governor Gianforte on February 12, 2021, released updated guidelines related to COVID-19 in his Executive Order 2-2021, and

WHEREAS, the Central Montana Health District is tasked with education, compliance and enforcement of the governor's directives,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Fergus County will continue to assist and support the Central Montana Health District in its role of providing guidelines and recommendations to citizens and businesses to continue to be responsible for following the governor's directives, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Fergus County encourages the Health District

to adopt the principles outlined in Governor Gianforte's Executive Order 2-2021 including development and implementation of industry best practices.
