

After meetings and discussion the Fergus County Insurance Committee recommends the following for the health insurance for FY 2020-2021:

- 1. Offer the following rate plans:**
 - a. RM 2000**
 - b. RM 3000**
 - c. BP 2000**
 - d. HD 3000**
 - e. HD 5000**

- 2. Keep the employer contribution to \$1030.00 and allow it to be used toward vision and dental if the employee chooses.**

- 3. Leave the life benefits the same.**
